New "Live Action" project exposes Planned Parenthood's illegal practices, urges Congress cut funding by Dustin Siggins Six years of undercover videos and phone calls show that Planned Parenthood engages in illegal and unethical behavior, according to the pro-life group Live Action's newest video and website project launched on 5/28/14. Live Action's "Planned Parenthood EXPOSED" project calls upon Congress to stop taxpayer funding of the

abortion giant. The videos show that Planned Parenthood clinic employees have ignored state laws that require the reporting of statutory rape, and encouraged lying about rape.



FEDERAL LEGISLATION

It is anticipated that, by the time you read this column, or shortly thereafter, the U.S. Supreme Court will have rendered its decisions in four cases of interest to pro-lifers.

- *McCullen v. Coakley* challenges a MA law which sets a 35 foot "bubble zone" around

abortion facilities. An eight foot "bubble zone" was upheld by the Court in 2009 (*Hill v. Colorado*). **The issue** is free speech and "viewpoint discrimination," since the 35 foot rule doesn't apply to people opposing any other topic or facility.

- Susan B. Anthony List, et al., v. Driehaus, et. al. SBA Ad said ObamaCare pays for abortions. Candidate Driehaus said it didn't, and charged SBA under the Ohio False Statement (campaign) Law. Driehaus lost his re-election bid and dropped the suit, but SBA continued it, versus Ohio Elections Commission. **The issue -** SBA's free speech and free-association rights, since its Ad was not allowed to run during the campaign.

- Conestoga Wood Specialties Corp. v. Sebelius and Sebelius v. Hobby Lobby. No Religious Organization cases have reached the Court.

NOTE: The LICL objects to Obamacare because of the parts in it that include abortion coverage at taxpaver expense, abortifacient contraception coverage at taxpayer expense, and direct or implicit limiting of care to vulnerable populations such as sick newborns and terminally ill. ACTION ALERT: Congress recesses from Aug. 4 – Sept 5. Contact or schedule a visit in your Senators' or Representative's local office. Bills the LICL is supporting include: - The Title X Abortion Provider Prohibition Act [HR 61, HR 217, S 135], the Prenatal Nondiscrimination Act (PRENDA) of 2013 [HR 447/S 138], the Child Interstate Abortion Notification Act (CIANA) [HR 732/S369], the Health Care Conscience Rights Act [HR 940/S1204], the No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act [HR 7, S142, S 946], and the Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act [HR 1797/S 1670]. Note that HR 7 & HR 1797 have passed the House, and await Senate action.

Some of the anti-life Bills the LICL objects to : - M.A.R.C.H. for Military Women Act [HR 1389, S.777] Allows abortions in military hospitals and facilities - Stop Deceptive Advertising for Women's Services Act [HR 2030, S. 981] to Harass Crisis Pregnancy centers - Access to Birth Control Act [HR 728, S.333] Has NO Pharmacist Conscience Protection (Bishop co-sponsors) - Follow the Money Act of 2013 Severely limits Ads by independent groups on pending Congress legislation. - Women's Health Protection Act of 2013 [HR 3471, S.1696] Removes almost all restrictions on abortions. The "Independence Party" is not the same as an

"Independent." The NYS Voter Registration Form rev. 09/2012 offers a choice of six parties. You may enroll in one of these: Democratic, Republican, Conservative, Working Families, Independence, or, Green.

Line 7 reads: "Other_____." You may write in a party not listed above.

Line 8 reads: "I do not wish to enroll in a party." By checking the box on Line 8 you are registering as an "Independent" meaning you do not enroll in a political party.

Gerald Benjamin of SUNY New Paltz said: "It [the Independence Party] largely exists because New York voters don't make the distinction between independent – that is, not enrolling in a party – and the Independence Party."

.....In 2012, the New York Daily News interviewed 200 New Yorkers who enrolled as Independence Party voters and said 169 of them thought they were not joining any party, but rather registering as "independent." Source: Newsday, 5/20/2014

HEALTH & SCIENCE Female Steroid Hormonal Drugs



For many years, we have heard warnings related to performance enhancing steroids (male steroid hormonal drugs) taken by boys and men to build muscle. One of the major risks of these drugs is liver cancer. Men and boys are warned not to take them because of the serious side effects. Female steroid hormonal drugs build breast tissue. They increase the risk of liver cancer, breast cancer and cervical cancer. These powerful steroid drugs are taken by millions of young girls and women in the form of birth control pills, emergency contraception (EC), Depo Provera injections, Seasonale (extended cycle pills), Implanon (rod inserted under the skin), Nuva Ring, Ortho Evra (patch), etc.

The estrogen and/or progestins in these products are designed to make a woman's body believe that it is pregnant month after month. All the vital organs in her body are affected by constant use. These artificial hormones suppress the woman's production of normal progesterone and estrogen. They work in one of three ways: prevent ovulation (release of egg from the ovary), change the mucus lining of the cervix to prevent sperm from entering, or irritate the lining of the uterus so that if the first two actions fail, and the woman becomes pregnant, the newly created life will be destroyed before attaching to the lining of the uterus. The third action is called a chemical abortion. Therefore, there is **always** the possibility that an early abortion can occur while a woman is using one of these products. Promoters of these products say that they do not cause abortion, but they are basing that statement on the incorrect notion that pregnancy begins when the baby implants in the lining of the womb. This is dishonest and scientifically false.

The serious side effects of female steroid hormonal drugs include: a weakened immune system, causing the woman to be more susceptible to AIDS (HIV) and bacterial infections, blood clots, stroke, cervical cancer, breast cancer, and ectopic pregnancy. These drugs offer no protection against sexually transmitted diseases including AIDS. Emergency contraception (morning after) pills contain mega doses of these steroid drugs. Young girls often have no idea of their family medical history, and can therefore put themselves at great risk by taking these drugs. The possibility of young girls placing themselves at such risk by using EC month after month (as a form of birth control) is frightening. (www.all.org, Education/Birth Control)

The January 2014 issue of Vanity Fair contained an article by Marie Brenner highlighting the possible dangers associated with newer (on the market since the 1990's) hormonal birth control. A study by the FDA noted that women using contraceptive rings have a higher risk of developing a venous thromboembolism (VTE) - a life-threatening blood clot. A New York law firm is working on multi-state litigation against drug companies over VTEs caused by 3rd and 4th generation birth control [containing desogestrel or drospirenone]. According to the website www.webmd, "It's worth noting that all hormonal birth control with added

estrogen carries a risk of blood clots...Some researchers say 3rd and 4th generation contraceptives raise the risk of blood clots without adding any benefit...[the director of the consumer watchdog group Public Citizen, Dr. Sidney Wolfe], reached an unequivocal conclusion: 'We've told people not to use these drugs.''' (www.consumerist.com/2014/01/03/9)

Teenage girls "are especially vulnerable to breast cancer risk because their breasts are growing and most have not vet developed cancer-resistant Type 3 lobules through a full -term pregnancy. Therefore, the cancer-causing combination contraceptive steroids (birth control pills) are especially dangerous for them. Breast tissue is made of lobules. A lobule is a unit of breast tissue that contains a milk duct and some milk producing glands. There are 4 types of lobules: Type 1- develop during puberty when estrogen levels rise and breasts develop; Type 2 - some form during puberty; Type 3 - form during pregnancy after 32 weeks; Type 4 actively produce milk. Before a full-term pregnancy, most of the breast is composed of Type 1 & 2 lobules, with Type 1 comprising 70% of the breast tissue. Together Type 1 & 2 lobules are where 95% of all breast cancers start. Therefore, steroid hormones are most damaging to the breast if taken before a full-term pregnancy. After a full-term pregnancy, most of the breast is composed of Type 3 lobules which are fully mature and resistant to cancer. This is why a full-term pregnancy lowers breast cancer risk and why women who remain childless have a higher risk of breast cancer. Both alone and in combination, the powerful steroids estrogen and progesterone and their synthetic equivalents (estrogen derivatives and progestins) can cause breast cancer through these 2 mechanisms: They cause the breast tissue to grow which can result in mutations and ultimately cancers; Estrogens can act as direct carcinogens causing cancer cells to form." (If it's not OK for him to take steroids...why is it OK for her?, Breast Cancer Prevention Institute, BCPI)

"The World Health Organization lists combined oral contraceptives in the highest level of cancer-causing agents [carcinogens] (Group 1). 'Most combined oral contraceptives are taken orally, but they can also be delivered by injection, transdermal patch or vaginal ring.' (Lancet Oncology 2005; 6: 552-553)" (*Why Aren't Women Being Told?*, Coalition on Abortion/Breast Cancer)

These synthetic steroids include ethinyl estradiol, conjugated estrogens, norgestrel, medroxyprogesterone, levonorgestrel, norethindrone, norethisterone, desogestrel, norgestinate, mestranol, drostirenone, onorgestrel, drospirenone, and ethynodiol. Although these steroids can decrease the risk of ovarian and endometrial cancer, it is not a good 'trade-off' in risk. (Out of 100 women with cancer, 31 have breast, 6 have endometrial and 3 have ovarian.) In 2002, the media exposed the risk of breast cancer from using HRT (hormone replacement therapy), and millions of women stopped taking the drugs. The same type of drugs are found in birth control pills and products in even higher doses. (BCPI)

Abortion, especially before a full-term pregnancy, also increases the risk of breast cancer, since the pregnancy ends while there is a larger amount of immature breast tissue which provides more sites for cancer initiation. (www.abortionbreastcancer.com)
